UNISI is looking for outstanding researchers wishing to apply under the call for applications MSCA-IF-2019 closing on 11 September 2019.

MSCA - Individual Fellowships offer the opportunity for experienced researchers (PhD holders or those with four years' full-time equivalent research experience) to secure their own funding within the framework of an individual project, which can last 12 to 36 months depending on the type of fellowship.

Candidates have to have lived, studied or worked in Italy for less than 12 months between September 2016 and September 2019.

This programme is open to all domains of research and innovation.

Candidates wishing to apply will be supported by the Research and Grants Management Division throughout the preparation of their proposal, with substantial information and guidance.
