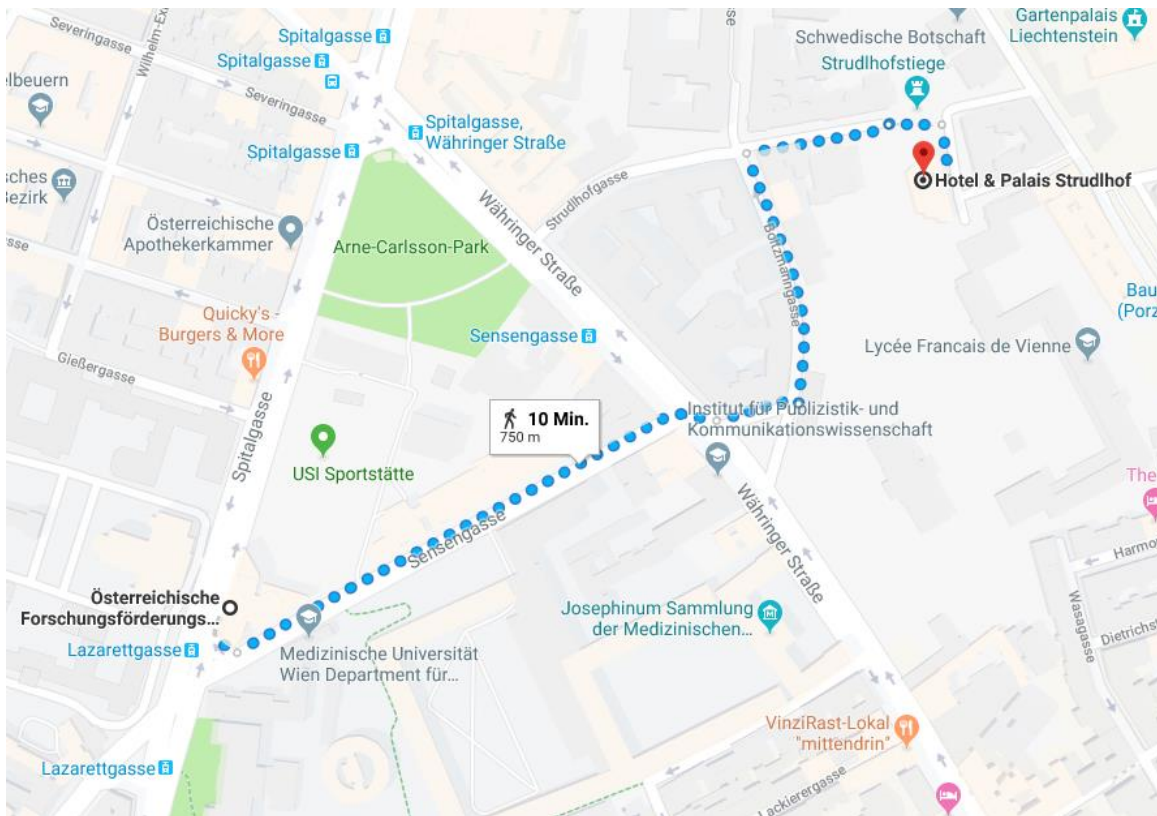

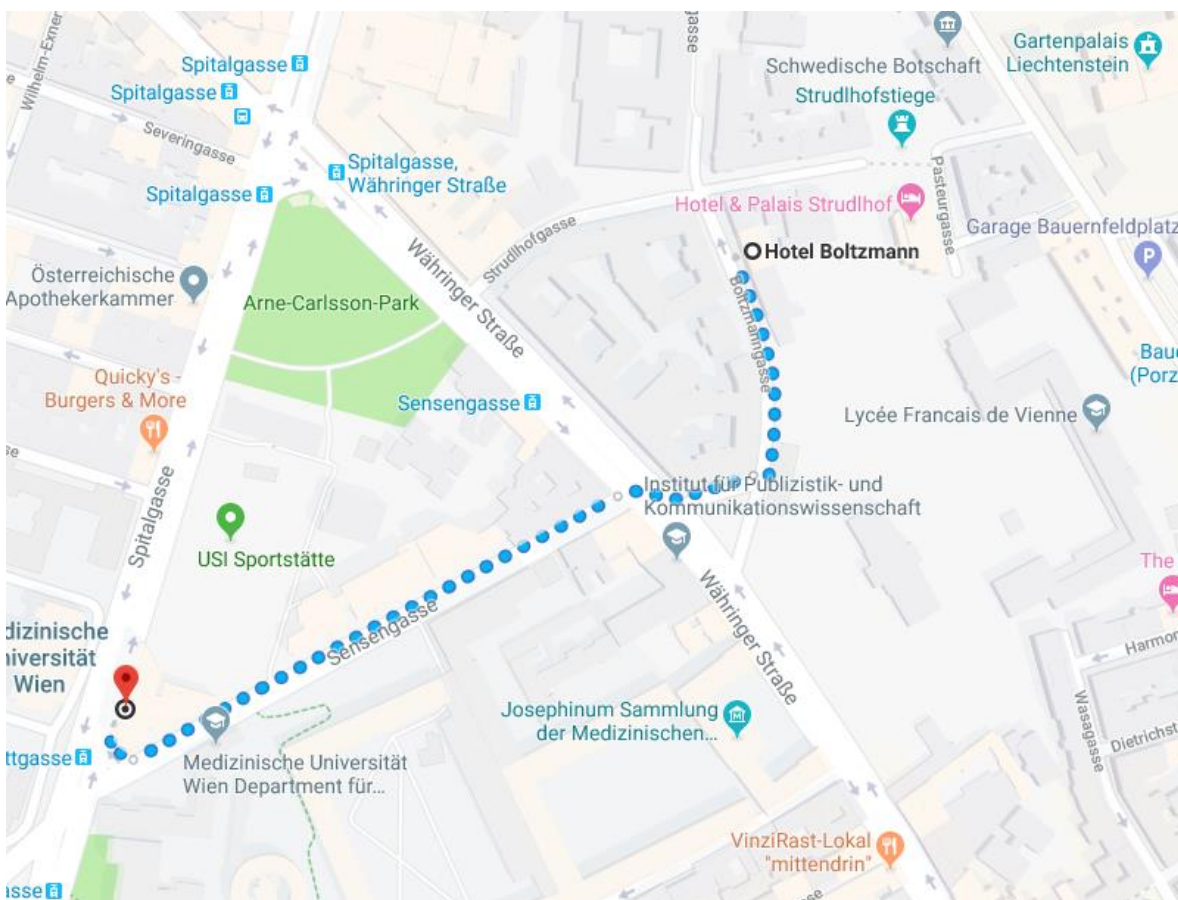

In order to confirm the reservation the hotels will need your credit card details, payment will be due upon check out. Bookings can be cancelled free of charge until three days before arrival.

**Arriving in Vienna**

**By Train:**

All ÖBB (Austrian Railway Services) Intercity, ÖBB Railjet, Eurocity and Euronight trains to Vienna stop at Vienna’s major train stations, “Hauptbahnhof” (Central Railway Station) or “Westbahnhof”.

The ÖBB – Austrian Federal Railways ([www.oebb.at/en](http://www.oebb.at/en)) as well as the private railway company WESTbahn ([westbahn.at/en](http://westbahn.at/en)) provide more information on the national railway system of Austria, train schedules and ticket prices. You can purchase tickets online, via electronic ticketing machines (English menu available) at the stations or ÖBB travel centers.

**By Plane:**

Vienna’s airport is the Vienna International Airport (VIE). Transport from the Airport to FFG / Hotel Strudlhof by:

**- City Airport Train (CAT):**

Departure from Vienna International Airport to City Air Terminal at Wien-Mitte Railway Station in only 16 minutes: non-stop every half-hour.

Tariff for the automatic ticket machines: Single Ticket € 12,00 /Return Ticket € 19,00

**- Bus service Vienna Airport Lines:**

Departure from Vienna International Airport to Vienna Morzinplatz/Schwedenplatz in only 20 minutes: non-stop every half-hour.

**- Underground: U4**

Departure from Wien-Mitte Railway Station (if you take the CAT) or Underground Station Schwedenplatz (if you take the bus), direction Heiligenstadt

Single Ticket: € 2,40 (**Attention:** For the use of the metro and the tram as described below you will need only one ticket!)

Stop at station Friedensbrücke/exit Friedensbrücke

**FFG:** Take Tram 5 or Tram 33 (direction Josefstädter Straße) to “Lazarettgasse” – you are in front of FFG’s building

**Hotel Strudlhof/Boltzmann:** Take Tram 5 or Tram 33 (direction Josefstädter Straße) to “Spitalgasse/Währinger Straße”. From there you will walk approx. 5 minutes to the hotels.

**- Taxi:** To go by taxi will be the most convenient and fastest way to get from the airport to the hotel and therefore the most expensive one – it will cost approx. € 35 one way. Usually you will find a taxi directly right next to the airport exit but you have also the possibility to order one in advance which we recommend during busy days: [www.airportdriver.at/en](http://www.airportdriver.at/en)

**- Entry and Visa in Austria**

Nationals of EU member states, the European Economic Area (EEA) and Switzerland do not require a visa for entering the Republic of Austria. All other nationals require a visa in order to enter the Schengen Area or the Austrian territory. A Schengen visa allows you to travel to all Schengen countries for up to 90 days in a six-month period. Visa applications can be submitted no earlier than 3 months and no later than 3 weeks before the start of your trip. **If you need a personal invitation for your trip, please indicate so when registering for the event.**
